## TRIP TO THE LOWRY - WEDNESDAY 26th MARCH 2025



As part of our Enrichment Pledge to you and your children, I have booked a day at The Lowry Theatre and Art Gallery on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> March. We will visit the permanent L.S. Lowry exhibition in the morning and look at a range of his works, sketching ideas and then producing a class composition when back in school. Then in the afternoon we will be off to the theatre at 2pm to see 'Pig-Heart Boy' based upon the novel by Malorie Blackman, which has been adapted to be appropriate for children aged 9 and above. https://thelowry.com/whats-on/177//pig-heart-boy

We will leave school by coach at 9.15am and return by 5.30pm. Please could the children wear full school uniform with a waterproof coat and bring a full packed lunch with additional drinks and snacks as it will be a long day!

We have managed to secure reduced ticket prices and the Friends of Hollinhey are supplementing transport costs, so the voluntary contribution to this amazing experience will be £30. Pupils will not need any money on the day. It is our policy to ensure that no child is excluded from visits due to financial hardship, so if it is not possible for you to pay the full amount, please contact us in advance as soon as possible. If your child is sick on the day a refund is at the discretion of the Headteacher.

We do not have any additional tickets for the show but if any parent or carer wishes to accompany us on the trip and help supervise, they could purchase their own ticket as there are some still available.

If your child would like a school packed lunch, this can be ordered in advance from school at the cost of £3.00 (Choice of tuna, ham or cheese sandwich).
